Locker Policy

- 1. Every upper unit will have a locker, including those upper units in the Elms.
- 2. Lockers will be directly below units wherever possible.
- 3. Lockers go with the units; when members relocate to another unit, they transfer their contents out at the same time.
- 4. On move-in, Management will assign lockers to units. The member will be provided with one key for the locker, one key for the back basementdoor and a copy of this policy.
- 5. On move-out, Management will verify that the locker has been vacated in good condition and that the keys have been returned.
- 6. All lockers, occupied or vacant, will remain locked at all times. Private locks are not allowed. The Co-op will supply a mastered padlock and one key for it.
- 7. Members are responsible for the cost of replacing lost locks and lost keys.
- 8. Co-op staff will keep records of locker assignments and spare keys.
- 9. The Co-op assumes no liability for the security of lockers, or for damage or loss of contents incurred by any reason whatsoever.
- 10. Lockers must be kept in tidy condition.
- 11. Members are not to store any of the following in the lockers:
 - Fuel and/or fuel containers
 - Fire accelerants such as paint
 - Any chemicals that can fuel fires
 - Loose papers and fibrous items
- 12. Members should not store the following in the lockers:
 - Valuables (eg: money, jewelry,etc.)
 - Memorabilia (eg: family pictures, important documents, etc.)
 - Food
 - Items that can be damaged by moisture or fluctuation in temperature
- 13. Members are to store their contents in the lockers as follows:
 - Ensure all items are placed in airtight and sealed containers.
 - Avoid placing items directly on the floor if possible, elevate them using metal shelves.
 - Do not leave any items outside of your assigned locker
 - Keep a log of the items stored in each container in the locker.
- 14. Members should obtain content and liability insurance
